### **Around-the-Clock Work Scheduled for Echo Summit Project** *Reversing One-Way Traffic Control Starting Monday*

ECHO SUMMIT – Caltrans is alerting the motoring public of a schedule change to its bridge construction project on U.S. Highway 50 over Echo Summit.

Beginning Monday afternoon at 3 p.m., work will take place **around the clock** until 10 a.m. Friday. There will be no weekend work, but the same schedule will resume the following week. Flaggers will be doing one-way reversing traffic control with delays of up to 20 minutes. The contractor will be excavating the roadway to build the bridge abutments.



This \$14.1 million project is replacing the existing sidehill viaduct, which was built in 1939, with a structure that meets current seismic standards. Construction started in May and will be completed either this fall or next spring.
